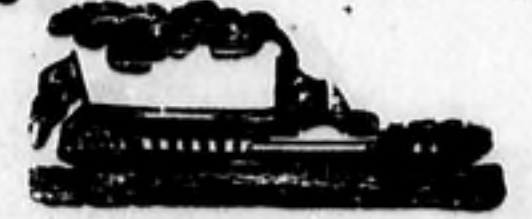


ENROLLMENT.

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Nathaniel T. Brown of

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Vermillion _____
Ohio _____ in the year 1842 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at
the Port of Buffalo New York the ninth day of November 1841 at 47
now surrendered having changed owners _____

the said Brig _____ or vessel has one deck _____ and two Mast _____ and that her
length is Eighty feet _____ 50 ft. in
her breadth Twenty feet and four inches _____ 20 " 4 "
her depth Eight feet _____ 8 " _____
and that she measures One hundred & twenty one _____ tons Twenty seven _____ ninety-fifths
that she is a (Brig) _____ has no gallies _____
_____ and a small _____ head.

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig _____ has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
