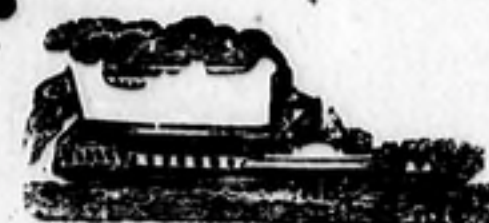

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Phil Duffer and John P. Davison of the same place are

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the *Cudora*, _____ whereof *John P. Davison* _____

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River Ohio* _____ in the year *1843* as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of *Cleveland Ohio* on the *6th* day of *September 1844* and numbered *444* forty four now surrendered having changed owners _____

And the said Enrollments _____ having certified that the said Schooner _____ or vessel has one Deck _____ and two Masts and that her length is *Eighty eight feet and one inch*, _____ her breadth *Twenty feet and seven inches*, _____ her depth *Eight feet and five inches* _____ and that she measures *One hundred thirty five* _____ tons *forty* _____ ninety-fifths: that she is a Schooner _____ has no galleries _____ and a *Revol* _____ head.

And the said *Calvin Bishop* _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
