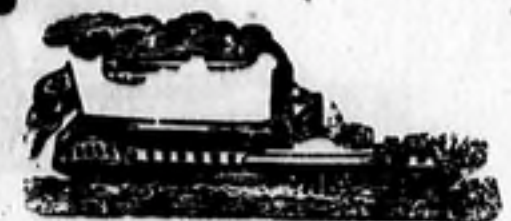

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Joseph Peabody of Buffalo Erie Co. New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Ralph Farnsworth of the same place

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner, Charles Howard whereof Elton Bigelow is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New York in the year 1845 as appears by her enrolment dated at this Port the 3^d day of September 1845 numbered 43 City three, now remanded having changed owners.

And the said enrolments having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is Seventy six feet and two inches her breadth Thirty feet and one inch her depth Seven feet and eight inches and that she measures One hundred & three tons, ninety four ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has and a small head.

And the said Joseph Peabody having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
