An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838. Patrick Short of Buffalo N.Y. — — — — — having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the Rainbow — — — — — whereof I own the Tandy — — — — — is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn — — — — — is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sheboygan W. T. — — — — — in the year 1844 as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of Detroit the 2<sup>d</sup> day of May 1845 numbered 3 (five) now surrendered having changed owners — — — — —

And the said Patrick Short — — — — — having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner — — — — — has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
