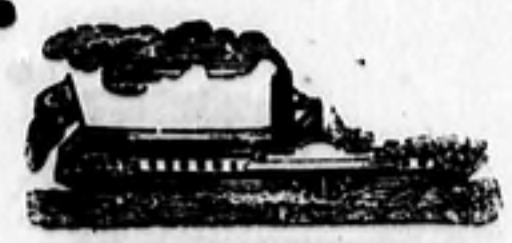

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

A. M. C. Smith of Buffalo Erie Co. New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Samuel A. Warner* of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Brig _____ or Vessel called the *St Louis of Buffalo* whereof *William Kyle* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Kalamazoo Michigan* in the year *1843* as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo N.Y. on the *10th* day of *June 1843*, now renewed and having changed owners.

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Brig _____ or vessel has *Two Masts* and *two decks*, and that her length is *Twenty seven feet and six inches*, her breadth *Twenty three feet and eleven inches*, her depth *Eight feet ten and one half inches* and that she measures *One hundred and eighty five* tons *seventy four* ninety-fifths that she is a *Brig* has *no* masts _____ and *small* _____ head.

And the said *A. M. C. Smith* _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
