An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838. Erastus Smith of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

And the said Erastus Smith \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
