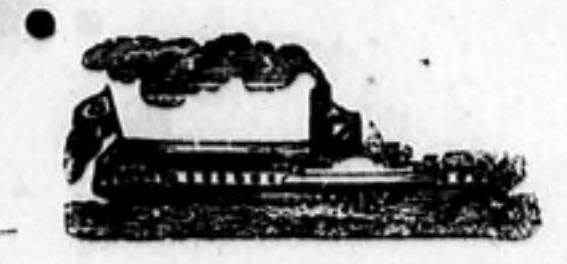

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Robert Wood of Buffalo New York
 having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Western Trader whereof *Robert Wood*
 is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
 Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Euclid*
Ohio in the year 1836 as appears by her Enrollment dated
 at this Port May 22nd 1845 and numbered twenty five (25)
 now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that
 the said Schooner or vessel has *One* Deck and *Two* masts and that her
 length is *fifty eight* feet and *nine* inches
 her breadth *Eighteen* feet
 her depth *five* feet and *ten* inches
 and that she measures *fifty three* tons *five* ninety-fifths
 that she is a *Schooner* has
 and a *scroll* head.

And the said *Robert Wood* having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
 mity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at
 the Port of Buffalo Creek.
