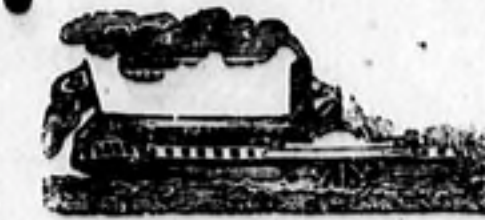

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838. *Jason Parker of Buffalo N.Y.* having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *A.S. Sterling of the same place*

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the *Sake Boat* or Vessel called the *Merchant* in which *John P. Nelson* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *St. Louis Mo.* in the year *1814* as appears by her Enrollment dated at this port the *10th* day of *April* *1843* numbered *10* Ten now *present* having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said *Sake Boat* or vessel has on deck and on masts and that her length is *Seventy eight feet and four inches* her breadth *fourteen feet and four inches* her depth *four feet + seven inches* and that she measures *Forty eight* tons *Twenty one* ninety-fifths. that she is *Sake Boat* has and head.

And the said *Jason Parker* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sake Boat* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
