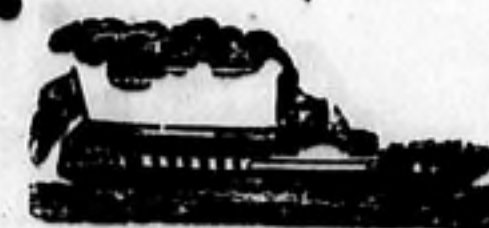

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Walter Jay of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with
George B. Webster Jacob Worcester and Frederick N. Jones of the same place are

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, Sole owners of the Propeller or Vessel called the
Pocahontas whereof *Jacob Worcester*
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo
New York in the year 1846 as appears by the certificate of
Fredrick N. Jones Master Builder dated May 6th 1846 on
file in this office

And the said Certificate having certified that
the said Propeller or vessel has one Deck and one Mast and that her
length is one hundred seventy one feet nine inches
her breadth twenty four feet eleven inches
her depth ten feet four and one half inches
and that she measures four hundred twenty six tons sixty four ninety-fifths:
that she is a Propeller has
and no figure head.

And the said *Walter Jay* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
