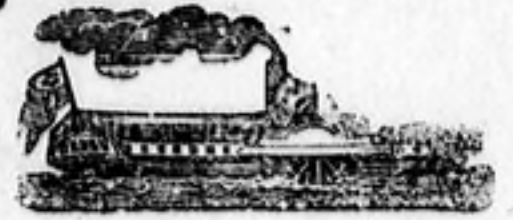

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y.  
in the year 1846 as appears by the certificate of  
Jacob W. Banta Master Builder dated the 1st day of May  
1846 now on file in this office \_\_\_\_\_

And the said certificate \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that  
the said Propeller or vessel has two Decks and two masts and that her  
length is one hundred & twenty feet one & one half inches -  
her breadth twenty six feet ten & one half inches -  
her depth ten feet six & three fourth inches -  
and that she measures four hundred & fifty - tons sixteen - ninety-fifths.  
that she is a Propeller \_\_\_\_\_ has  
and a figure \_\_\_\_\_ had.

And the said Oliver Bugbee \_\_\_\_\_ having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller St Joseph has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
