

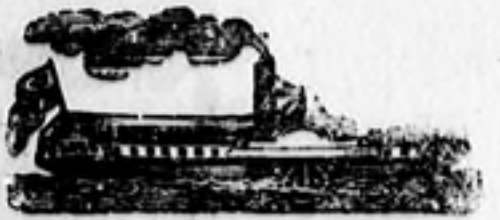

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Philo Duffer of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is gotten with Calvin Bishop of the same place and Aaron Root of Black River Ohio

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the

Vincennes of Buffalo whereof *Aaron Root* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River Ohio* in the year 1846 as appears by the certificate of *William Jones* builder dated at the port of *Buffalo* May 13th 1846 now on file in this office

And the said certificate having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is *One hundred & four feet and nine inches* her breadth *two feet, three feet and ten inches* her depth *eight feet and two inches* and that she measures *One hundred & eighty five tons thirty* ninety-fifths that she is *Schooner* has and a *scroll* head.

And the said *Philo Duffer* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *thirtieth* day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty *six*.
