IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John J. Townsend of Buffalo N.Y.  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Brig or Vessel called the  
Odd Fellows whereof Harry D. Pratt of Cleveland Ohio  
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio

in the year 1846 as appears by her Enrollment dated  
at the Port of Cleveland the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April 1845 numbered  
17 Seventeen now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that  
the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her  
length is one hundred and seven feet nine inches  
her breadth twenty four feet and four inches  
her depth nine feet and five inches  
and that she measures two hundred and twenty four tons sixty four ninety-fifths:  
that she is a Brig has no gallery a square stern  
and a figure head.

And the said John J. Townsend having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
