IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry Randall of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with J.N. Jones of the same place & William Jones, the Estate of Barney Makers, David T. Baldwin of Black River Ohio A. B. Latis Franklin Wiley Ervach Clarke and Isaac Ordens of Clysia John F. Churty & Co of Huron Ohio Townsend and Hudson Root Davison & Co of Starkbury and H.C. Carpenter & Co of Toledo being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the Seymour of Buffalo whereof Henry Randall is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio in the year 1835 as appears by his enrollment dated at this Port the 20th day of August 1844 Numbered Fifty one (51) now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Steam Boat or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is One hundred and sixty two feet her breadth Twenty two feet and six inches her depth Eleven feet and one inch and that she measures Three hundred & sixty three tons fifty three ninety-fifths that she is Steam Boat has no galeries and a figure head.

And the said Henry Randall having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
