IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry M. Kinne of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Brig or Vessel called the Empire of Buffalo wherof Squire Alexander of Buffalo is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Enclide Ohio in the year 1844. as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port, the ninth day of May, 1844, and numbered twenty nine - 29. now surrendered having changed owners And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is one hundred twenty five feet and seven inches her breadth twenty six feet and eleven inches her depth nine feet and seven inches and that she measures two hundred thirty seven tons thirteen ninety-fifths: that she is a Brig has no Gally and a Scull head.

And the said Henry M. Kinne having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
