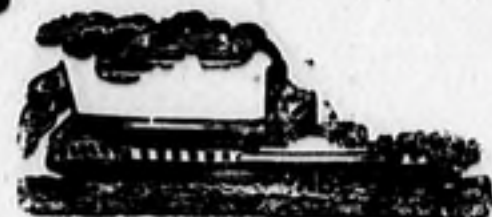




# ENROLLMENT.



DISTRICT OF BUFFALO CREEK, }  
PORT OF BUFFALO CREEK.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

*Richard Sears* of Buffalo New York  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with  
*John M. Griffith* of the same place, *Silvester F. Utwood*, *Thomas Clark* 2<sup>d</sup>  
*Samuel C. Forsyth*, and *Henry A. Forsyth* of Mammee City Ohio

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the  
*Procy* of Buffalo whereof *Silvester F. Utwood*  
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Mammee City Ohio  
in the year 1845 as appears by her last Enrollment  
dated at this port July 9<sup>th</sup> 1845 numbered thirty five (35) now  
sundered.

And the said Enrollment having certified that  
the said Steam Boat or vessel has two decks and one mast and that her  
length is one hundred and eighty two feet six inches  
her breadth twenty seven feet and six inches  
her depth eleven feet and four and one half inches  
and that she measures five hundred and forty six tons forty seven ninety-fifths  
that she is a Steam Boat has no gullies  
and no head.

And the said *Richard Sears* having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
