An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Broaddock Black of Evans N. Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with James Thompson of the same place and Maria Pickett of New York N. Y. are

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Sloop Schooner or Vessel called the B. whereof Broaddock Black is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Irving New York in the year 1845 as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port the second day of June 1845 numbered Twenty seven (27) now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Sloop Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is fifty feet and ten inches her breadth fourteen feet and four inches her depth three feet and eight inches and that she measures twenty six tons twelve ninety-fifths that she is a Sloop Schooner has no gallies, a Square Stern and no figure head.

And the said Broaddock Black having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
