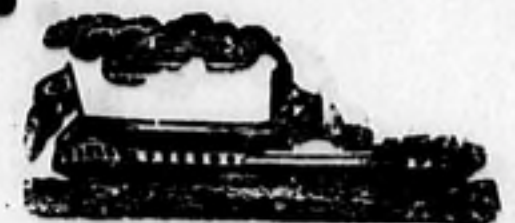

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Dean Richmond of Buffalo, N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Symon Crowl and S. C. DeLoach of this City Ohio are

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Outward Bound, whereof Symon Crowl is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1846, as appears by her Enrollment dated at Cleveland the 29th day of June 1846. Number 31. Not Surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one Deck and two masts and that her length is One hundred and twenty feet and three inches her breadth Twenty four feet and her depth Ten feet and that she measures Two hundred thirty two tons twenty nine hundred and ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square Stern and a Small head.

And the said Dean Richmond having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
