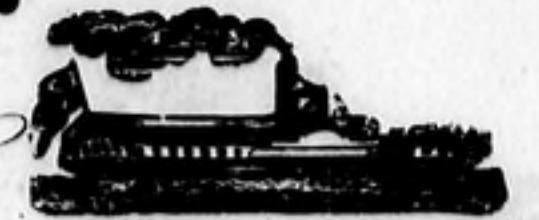

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John Hollister of Buffalo N.Y. managing owner
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he *Agrees with Amos Pratt of the same place* and

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Propeller or Vessel called the

Princeton whereof *Amos Pratt* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Lorystown Ohio* in the year *1845* as appears by her last Enrollment dated at the Port the *16th* day of *May 1845* number *24*. which said last Enrollment has been lost or mislaid as appears by the oath of said *Amos Pratt* master dated the *14th* day of *August 1846* now on file in this office. And he said last Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has *One Deck* and *Three Masts* and that her length is *One hundred & twenty seven feet ten inches* her breadth *twenty four feet & six inches* her depth *ten feet & ten inches* and that she measures *From hundred & fifty five tons seventy three ninety-fifths*: that she is a Propeller has no galleries and no head.

And the said *John Hollister* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
