And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has *One Deck* and *two Masts* and that her
length is *Eighty five feet*
her breadth *Twenty feet*
her depth *Eight feet and two inches*
and that she measures *One hundred + Eighteen tons* *ninety-fifths*
that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries*
and is *Swell* head.

And the said *Fredrick W. Jones* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
