

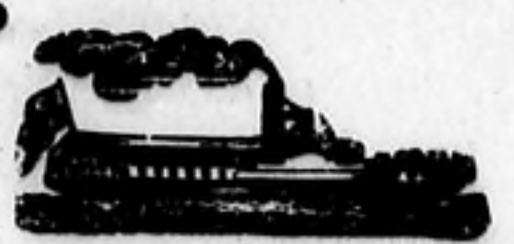

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels, ~~used~~ in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry M. Kinn, attorney for Alfred Kinn of New York having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Orson Shepard of Ashtabula are

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the Windham whereof Lorin Shepard is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ashtabula Ohio in the year 1845, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at the Port of New York Jan 3. 1843 + number sixteen (16)

And the said Enrollment \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has two masts and one deck and that her length is one hundred twelve feet one and one half inches her breadth twenty five four inches her depth nine feet two inches and that she measures two hundred thirty six tons eight ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has \_\_\_\_\_ and a scull head.

And the said Henry M. Kinn atty. for Alfred Kinn having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
