

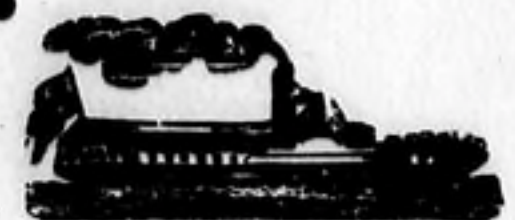

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels, ~~used~~ in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Jeremiah A. Peabody of Buffalo *ens.*
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Brig _____ or Vessel called the *Frances Mills* whereof Benjamin F. Davidson is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Michigan City Indiana in the year 1840 as appears by her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Detroit May 17, 1846, and numbered twenty eight - 28, now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is seventy six feet _____ her breadth twenty two feet _____ her depth eight feet _____ and that she measures one hundred & fifteen tons twenty four ninety-fifths that she is a Brig _____ has _____ and a small _____ head.

And the said Jeremiah A. Peabody _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
