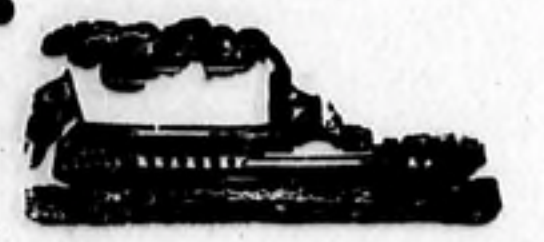

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Samuel J. Atwater of Buffalo New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Congress* whereof *W. A. Prudden* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Algonne Michigan* in the year 1844 as appears by Her Enrollment No. *6* at the Port of *Port Huron* on the *22*th day of *Sept* - *May 18* 1846. Now surrendered by reason of a change of owner and the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *On No* and *Two Mast*, and that her length is *Ninety Five* feet her breadth *Twenty Seven* feet her depth *Nine* feet & *Eight* inches and that she measures *Two Hundred & Six* tons *Thirty Two* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has *One* Masted and a *Screw* Propeller

And the said *Samuel J. Atwater* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Congress* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *21*th day of *October* in the year one thousand eight hundred and *forty* six
