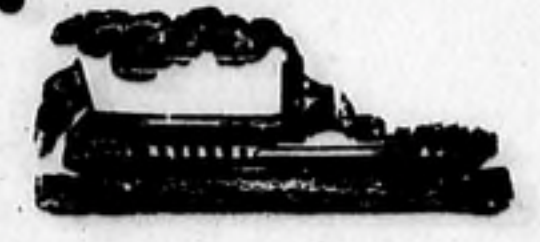

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Presque Isle Pa.
in the year 1831, as appears by her last Enrollment dated
at this Port the 17th day of October 1840.

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her
length is seventy nine feet and six inches
her breadth twenty two feet and two and one half inches
her depth seven feet eight and one half inches
and that she measures One hundred twenty two tons twenty two ninety-fifths:
that she is a Schooner has no gallery
and a Billet head.

And the said Benjamin Bidwell having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
