

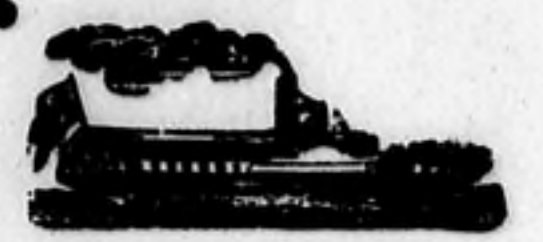

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Stephen Baright of Lockport NY
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Lake Boat or Vessel called the Oregon whereof said Stephen Baright is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Thira N. Post in the year 1846 as appears by the Oath of said Stephen Baright and the certificate of Mrs Mack surveyor

And the said certificate having certified that the said Lake Boat or vessel has one Deck and that her length is Seventy seven feet & six inches her breadth fourteen feet & six inches her depth six feet & five inches and that she measures Sixty seven tons thirty six ninety-fifths that she is a Lake Boat has and no figure head.

And the said Stephen Baright having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Lake Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this seventeenth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty six
