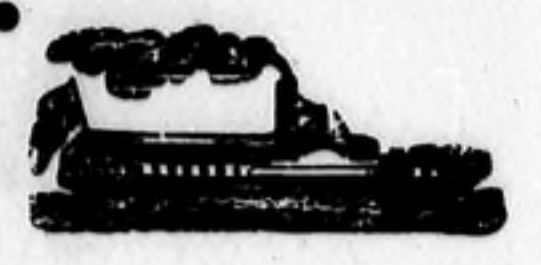

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

George B. Dwight of Dunkirk N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with William W. Brigham, George Bradley and Edward I. Shem of Dunkirk N.Y. are

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *E. Whittelsey* whereof Alexander C. Beegs is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ashtabula Ohio in the year 1831 as appears by her Enrollment data at Cleveland Ohio May 30<sup>th</sup> 1842 and Numbered twenty seven 27 now surrendered having changed names

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is sixty one feet and six inches her breadth seventeen feet eight inches her depth five feet and three inches and that she measures forty nine tons sixty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a screw head.

And the said George B. Dwight having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this seventeenth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty six.
