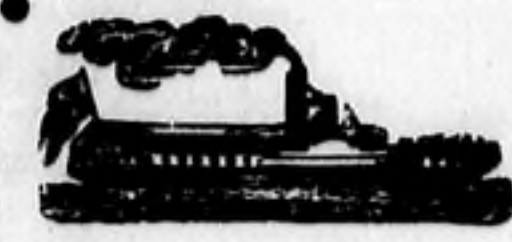

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with
Charles M. Aville of the same place*

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Amoria Biscalle* whereof *Charles M. Aville* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Oswego* in the State of *New York* in the year 1835 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at the Port of *Oswego* September 18th and Number 561 Tons 54
New Amundson having changed owner
And the said Enrollment having certified that the said *Schooner* or vessel has *One Mast* and two masts and that her length is *Seventy five feet* her breadth *Nineteen feet and four inches* her depth *Seven feet and three inches* and that she measures *Ninety four tons forty ninety-fifths* that she is a *Schooner* has a *Square Stern*, *No gallery* and a *Scroll* head.

And the said *Amitor Davidson* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
