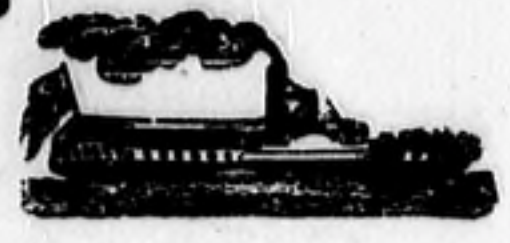

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together
with John S. Provost of the same place and Edwin
Dirbion of Huron Ohio are the

SOLE OWNERS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Prestchester whereof Edwin Dirbion
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron Erie
County Ohio in the year 1846 as appears by the certificate of J. Ketchum
Builder now on file in this office -

And Wm. G. Mack Surveyor having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her
length is one hundred and eleven feet and three inches,
her breadth twenty three feet and five inches
her depth eight feet eight inches
and that she measures two hundred and seven tons sixty one ninety-fifths
that she is a schooner + has
and a screw head.

And the said James P. Provost having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
