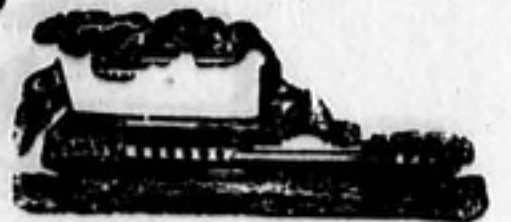

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

*James Butler of Buffalo N.Y.*  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Sloop *Sturtevant* or Vessel called the *Sturtevant* whereof the said *James Butler* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Batteraugus* in the year 1844 as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port June 10. 1845 and numbered twenty nine now surrendered having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Sloop or vessel has one Deck and one Mast and that her length is fifty five feet and four inches her breadth nineteen feet her depth six feet seven inches and that she measures fifty eight tons twenty ninety-fifths that she is a Sloop has and a Stern head.

And the said *James Butler* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
