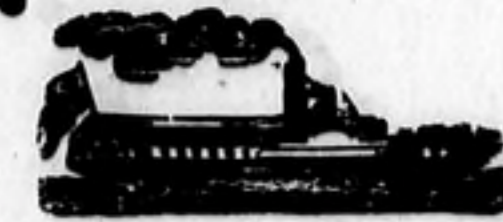

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Levi Elliott of Buffalo N.Y.  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Nathan Perryman

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the "Paltio" whereof Amasa D. Perryman is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo in the year 1847 as appears by the certificate of Jacob W. Banta Surveyor in file in this Office.

And the said certificate having certified that the said Steamboat or vessel has one deck and length is One hundred twenty five feet and that her breadth thirty feet and her depth twelve feet and that she measures Eight hundred twenty five tons that she is a Steam Boat has one mast and a Figure head.

And the said Levi Elliott having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this twenty fifth day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty seven
