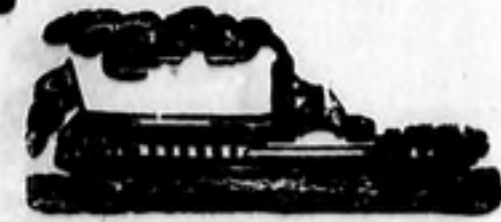


ENROLLMENT.



DISTRICT OF BUFFALO CREEK, PORT OF BUFFALO CREEK.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Samuel Purdy of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Harriet Calvin* whereof *Waffle* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Point Peninsula New York in the year 1840 as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port March 19. 1845. and numbered one (1), now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one Deck and two Masts, and that her length is ninety feet her breadth twenty feet her depth eight feet and four inches and that she measures one hundred forty three tons eighty one ninety-fifths: that she is a Schooner has a square Stern and a figure head.

And the said Samuel Purdy having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this Seventh day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty seven
