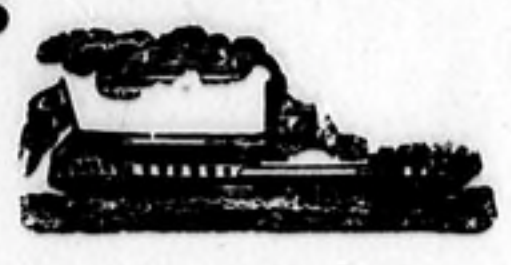

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

William Hughes of Oswego N.Y. by his Attorney James W. Spauld
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the *Big* or Vessel called the
Wosier whereof *James W. Spauld*
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn that he is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River*
Ohio in the year *1847* as appears by the Enrollment
dated at the Port of Buffalo N.Y. September 17th 1844 and
numbered *fifty eight (58)* and that she has since been changed
and the said Enrollment having certified that
the said *Big* or vessel has *One* Mast and *Two* masts and that her
length is *thirty five feet and six inches*
her breadth *Twenty four feet and five inches*
her depth *Three feet and four inches*
and that she measures *One hundred thirty three* tons *thirty* ninety-fifths
that she is a *Big* has no gallies
and has a *Scow* head.

And the said *William Hughes* by his Attorney having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in con-
formity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Big* has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
