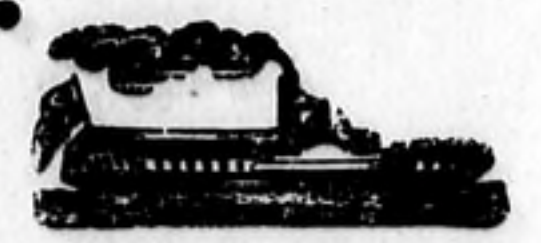

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

William Laughlin of Chicago by his Attorney Anthony M. Spring taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a citizen of the United States & sole owner of the Brig *Albion* of the said District (subject only to a Mortgage dated the 30th day of April 18th June to Bidwell & Bent for the sum of Three hundred and thirty dollars) to which is an endorsement of One hundred Dollars dated April 30th 1841

*Albion* whereof Richard Moon is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1834 as appears by the Enrollment dated at this Port the 6th day of May 1846 and was entered Twenty and 1/2 tons now surrendered having changed owner. And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Ship or vessel has One deck and Two masts and that her length is Thirty Nine feet & no inch her breadth Twenty five feet and two inch and her depth Nine feet and five inch and that she measures Two hundred & thirty One nine eighths tons that she is a Brig has No galley and a figure head.

And the said William Laughlin by his Attorney having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this 17th day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty four.
