

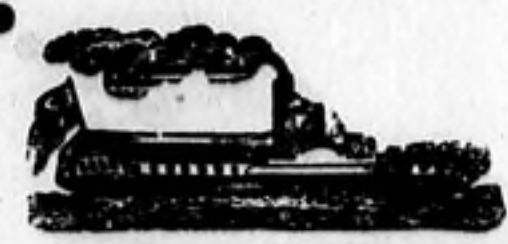

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Richard Sears of Buffalo Ohio Co. N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts; and having sworn that he together with
John W. Griffith, and John D. Edmund
of Monroe Michigan

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Steamboat or Vessel called the
Cleveland of Buffalo whereof John D. Edmund
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Western Ohio
in the year 1837, as appears by her Enrollment dated

at this port the twenty fourth day of March 1846 and numbered
(3) New Steamboat having changed owner
And said Enrollment having certified that
the said Steam Boat or vessel has One deck and One mast and that her
length is One hundred & Eighty feet
her breadth Twenty eight feet
her depth Eleven feet eight and half inches
and that she measures Three hundred & Twenty one tons Eighty six ninety-fifths
that she is a Steam Boat has no gallery
and a screw had.

And the said John D. Edmund having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-
ity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
