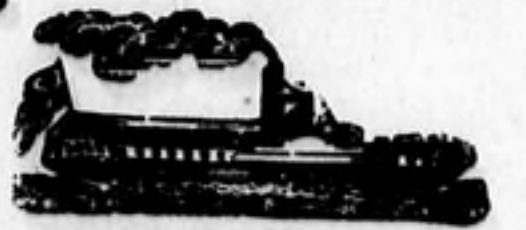

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Paul Ruffer of Buffalo Erie County New York,
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with
with Leavin Bishop and George W. Floyd of the
same place,

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Fin Davis whereof George W. Floyd
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio

in the year 1844. as appears by the Enrollment dated

the twenty fifth day of April 1844. Numbered

length is One hundred and Eleven feet three inches

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-

mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at

the Port of Buffalo Creek.
