

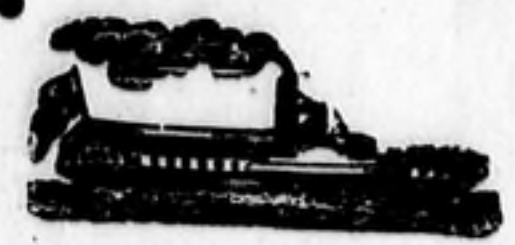

IN CONFORMITY TO
An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing
Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and
Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for
other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives
of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838. Robert
Miles of Buffalo Creek County, N.Y. No. _____
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together
with the crew of "Tumanda" is

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
"Tumanda" whereof Robert Miles is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sagadahoc
in the year 1836 as appears by the Enrollment dated at this Port the 10th day of October 1846.

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her
length is Seventy nine feet and six inches
her breadth Twenty two feet and one half inch
her depth Seven feet eight inches and one half inch
and that she measures One hundred and twenty two tons Seventy nine ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no gallery
and a bell.

And the said Robert Miles having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
