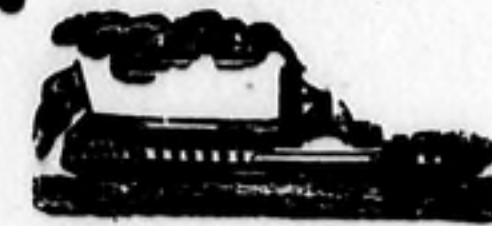

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Walter Jay of Buffalo, Erie County, N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with
John P. [unclear] of the same place and Joseph P. Hall
of Ashtabula Ohio

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner [unclear] of Vessel called the
[unclear] whereof Joseph P. Hall
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn [unclear] is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y.
in the year 1847 as appears by Certificate of the
Builder Frederick W. Jones on file in this Office

And the said Certificate [unclear] having certified that
the said Schooner a vessel has One deck and Two masts, and that her
length is One hundred and thirteen feet & six inches
her breadth Twenty three feet and four inches
her depth Eight feet & six inches
and that she measures One hundred & Eighty tons Seventy and nine-fifths;
that she is a Schooner has
and a Stern head.

And the said Walter Jay [unclear] having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
