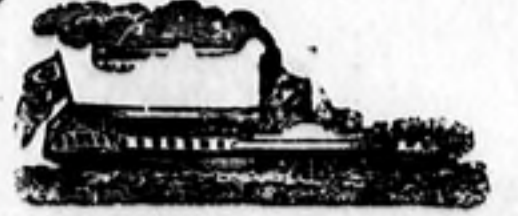

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry M. Harris of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken and subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the Old Pelican of Buffalo whereof Wm Phillips of the same place is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1845 as appears by Her Enrollment

dated at said Port the fifteenth day of May 1846 Number 30 Thirty two hundred thirty and one And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Ship or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is One hundred and seven feet and nine inches her breadth Twenty four feet and four inches her depth Seven feet and four inches and that she measures Two hundred thirty four tons Twenty four ninety-fifths that she is a Ship has No gallery and a square head.

And the said Henry M. Harris having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Ship has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this thirteenth day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty.
