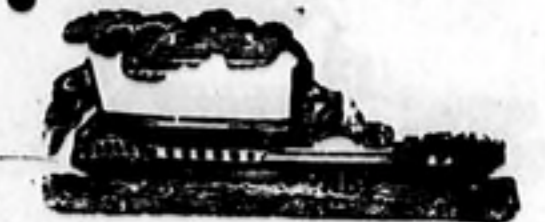




ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 13th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Ambrose S. Stealing of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with
Mrs B Stealing of the same place,

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Tang of Buffalo whereof Edward [unclear] of Buffalo
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn
is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at [unclear]
Ohio in the year 1843 as appears by her Enrollment

dated at this Port the twenty first day of June
1843 and numbered (22) and [unclear] being changed
And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her
length is Eighty three feet eight and a half inches
her breadth Twenty feet and six inches
her depth Eleven feet and Eleven inches
and that she measures One hundred twenty tons ninety fifths
that she is a Schooner has no gallies
and a [unclear] head.

And the said Ambrose S. Stealing having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified and sufficient security having been given in conform-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
