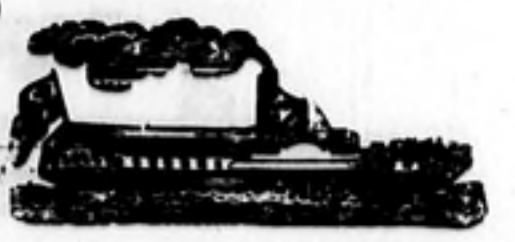




ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

William Buckley of Buffalo, N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *W.A. Adair* whereof *James McDell*

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *St. Charles River Ohio* in the year *1845* as appears by his Enrollment dated at the Port of *Cleveland* July 21. 1846, numbered *thirty five (35)* and amended having changed name, and rebuilt at *Buffalo, N.Y.* in 1847 as appears by the certificate of *McDell* and that said certificate

the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is *Eighty one* feet and *nine* inches her breadth *Seventeen* feet and *eight* inches her depth *Six* feet and *two* inches and that she measures *Eighty one* tons *fifty* and *ninety-fifths* that she is a Schooner has and *Scull* head.

And the said *William Buckley* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *Twenty* day of *April* in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty *seven*
