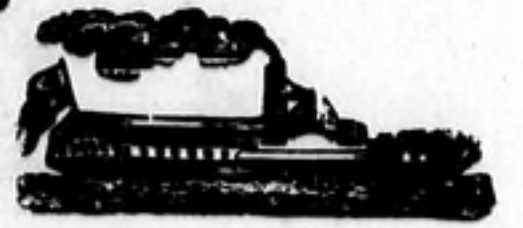

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Jesse N. Peabody of Buffalo New York.
Having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with
Crested Smith and John Peabody of the same
place

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the *Steam Boat* or Vessel called the
Rochester whereof *David J. Pheto*
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Richmond*
City Ohio in the year 1838. as appears by *How Enrollment*
dated *the twentieth day of September 1844* and
Number *Sixty (60)* and *summons having changed name*

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Steamboat or vessel has *One deck* and *Two masts* and that her
length is *One Hundred fifty eight and five eighths*
her breadth *Twenty seven and six eighths*
her depth *Seven feet and six eighths*
and that she measures *Four hundred twenty two tons* *Eight and ninety-fifths*
that she is a *Steam Boat* has *Two sails*
and a *Forward head* head.

And the said *Jesse N. Peabody* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.

in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty *four*
