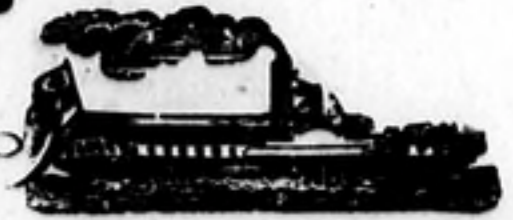


ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

William Buckley of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Masius Minick, Paulus O. Humant and Constant B. Jayme,

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the New Month whereof Masius Minick is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y.

in the year 1817 as appears by the certificate of the Master Builder Jacob W. Banta on file in this Office (dated the 20th of April 1847.)

And the said certificate having certified that the said Ship or vessel has One deck and Two masts, and that her length is One hundred and Eighteen, Eight inches her breadth Twenty five feet and two inches her depth Five feet seven inches and that she measures Two hundred and thirty and seven ninety-fifths tons that she is a Brig has Two square masts and a Scow head

And the said William Buckley having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this Twenty day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty.
