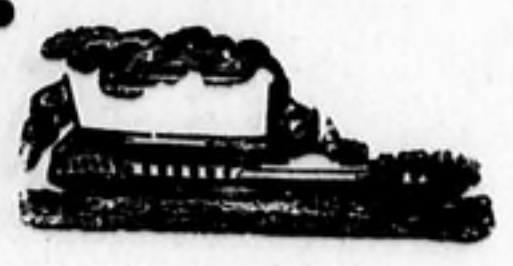




# ENROLLMENT.



DISTRICT OF BUFFALO CREEK,

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry W. Hines of Buffalo N.Y.  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Morris Hayward and Sylvester W. Conwright of the same place

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Buffalo of Buffalo, whereof Sylvester W. Conwright is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1847 as appears by the certificate of the Master builder Jacob W. Bantow on file in this Office dated the Twenty day of April 1847,

And the said Jacob W. Bantow having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is One hundred & fifteen feet three inches 115-3 her breadth Twenty five feet and four inches 25-4 her depth Three feet four and One half inches 3-4 1/2 and that she measures Two hundred & fifty tons Twelve ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square head.

And the said Henry W. Hines having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this Twenty day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty.
