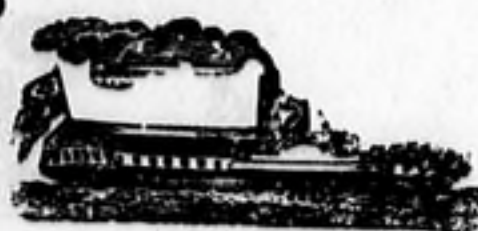

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the Propeller whereof Robert Hart

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio City in the year 1847 as appears by the certificate of the Master Builder dated the first day of May 1847 now on file in this Office

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has One deck and One mast and that her length is One hundred forty feet 140 ft her breadth Twenty two feet, four and one half inches 22 - 4 1/2 her depth Seven feet and three inches 7 - 3 and that she measures Two hundred twenty tons 220 tons Sixty three 63 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has one funnel and a rigid head.

And the said Robert Hart having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this first day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty seven.
