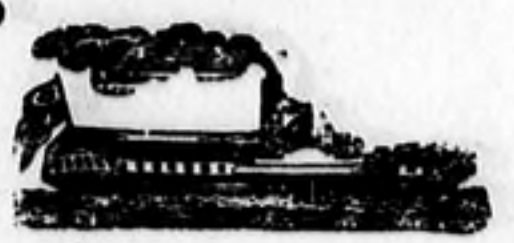

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Wm. Richards of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with
William J. Morrison of the same place

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Henry M. Brown whereof *William J. Morrison* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ann Arbor O.* in the year 1841 as appears by *How Enrollment*

dated at the Port of *Cleveland* the 29th October 1844 and numbered *Thirty and 1071* and *summers* having changed owner
And the said *Enrollment* having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *Two* masts, and that her length is *Twenty eight* feet and *Eight* inches *78-8* her breadth *Twenty* feet and *One* quarter inch *20 1/4* her depth *Seven* feet and *One* quarter inch *7 1/4* and that she measured *One hundred & Eleven* tons *Twenty* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no gallery and a *single* head.

And the said *Wm. Richards* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *5th* day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty *four*
