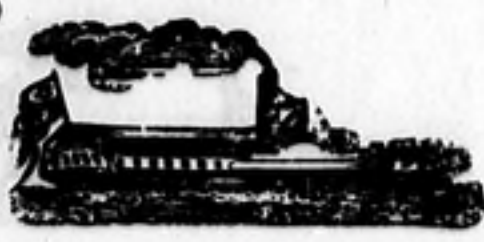




ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Joseph Satter of Buffalo NY
Having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Charles Howard whereof William Pigeon
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at

in the year 1815 as appears by the Enrollment
dated at this Port the Eighteenth day of November
1846 and numbered 1751 and being changed

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and One mast, and that her
length is Seventy five feet and two inches
her breadth Twenty feet and One inch
her depth Seven feet and Eight inches
and that she measures One hundred three tons thirty four ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a single

And the said Joseph Satter having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.

in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty.
