IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry W. Putnam of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken & subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Minerva* whereof Henry W. Putnam is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cleveland Ohio* in the year 1835 as appears by *His Enrollment* dated at Buffalo N.Y. the *third* day of *November* *1845* and *summed* having *checked* and *And* *His* *Sworn* *certificates* having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *one deck* and *two masts*, and that her length is *fifty* *seven* feet and *five* inches *57-11* her breadth *eight* feet and *six* inches *18-6* her depth *six* feet and *eight* inches *6-8* and that she measures *sixty* tons *sixty* *four* *ninety-fifths* that she is a Schooner has no galley and a *single* head.

And the said Henry W. Putnam having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
