IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Araron P. Putee of Lockport N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the *General Boat* or Vessel called the *Albatross* whereof *Araron P. Putee* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Rochester N.Y.* in the year *1845*, as appears by the Certificate of *the said Araron P. Putee* dated *May 8. 1847* now on file in this office

And the Certificate of *William J. M. Johnson* having certified that the said *Boat* or vessel has *one deck* and _____ and that her length is *seventy three feet and four inches* her breadth *thirteen feet and three inches* her depth *four feet and three inches* and that she measures *thirty two* tons *thirty* ninety-fifths that she is a *General Boat* has _____ and _____ head.

And the said *Araron P. Putee* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *General Boat* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
