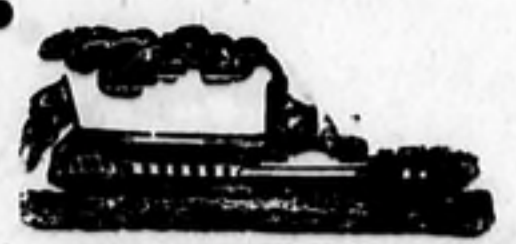

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

H. L. P. Folger of Buffalo N.Y.  
 having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with  
 Giles W. Coats of Buffalo N.Y.

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the  
 Lewis Folger whereof Julius W. B. is  
 is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a  
 Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River  
 in the year 1846, as appears by the Enrollment  
 dated at the Port of Cleveland Ohio the twentieth  
 day of September 1846, numbered Forty Seven 47, thus  
 And the said Enrollment having certified that  
 the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her  
 length is Ninety seven feet and eight inches 97-8  
 her breadth Twenty three feet and two inches 23-10  
 her depth Three feet and two inches 3-2  
 and that she measures One hundred Ninety and two tons seventy nine ninety-fifths  
 that she is a Schooner has a Square Stern  
 and a Sloop head.

And the said H. L. P. Folger having  
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in con-  
 formity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at  
 the Port of Buffalo Creek.
