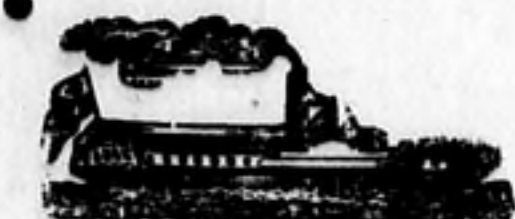




# ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

*William B. King* of Buffalo New York, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Anders L. Magnus* *Erastus B. Magnus* and *Erastus Smith* of Buffalo,

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Brigantine or Vessel called the *Erwald* whereof *Oliver Palmer* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Lebanon* in the year 1841 as appears by *Her Enrollment*

dated at the Port of *Lebanon* on the *thirtieth* day of *August* 1844. *Oliver Palmer* having certified that the said Brigantine or vessel has *One deck* and *Two masts* and that her length is *One hundred & One foot and Six inches* 101 ft 6 in her breadth *Twenty three feet and two inches* 23 " 2 her depth *Eight feet and eight inches* 8 " 8 and that she measures *One hundred & Eighty five tons* forty ninety-fifths that she is a Brigantine has *no gallery* and a *single* head.

And the said *William B. King* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brigantine has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *5th* day of *August* in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty.
