

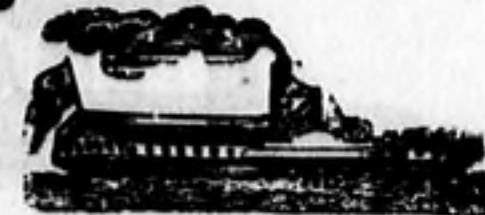

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Samuel G. Atwater of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
"Merrill N. Sibley" whereof Edward M. Crowl
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y.
in the year 1847 as appears by the certificate of
H. A. Jones Master-builder on file in this Office

And the said certificate having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has two masts and one deck and that her
length is One hundred and fourteen feet and eleven inches 11 1/2
her breadth Twenty four feet seven inches 7 1/2
her depth Nine feet and eleven inches 11
and that she measures Two hundred and fifty two tons Eighteen ninety-fifths
that she is Schooner has
and built head

And the said Samuel G. Atwater having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in con-
formity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
